Main Show or Event – per show day with attendance of 25,001 and above:	£148

Previously, businesses and organisations had to obtain separate music licences from PPL and PRS for Music. However, PPL and PRS for Music have now created a new joint venture called PPL PRS Ltd to deliver all their UK public performance licensing, creating a single point of contact for customers and launching TheMusicLicence.

“TheMusicLicence” allows you to legally play music for employees or customers in your business through a radio, TV, other digital devices or a live performance.

Shows will save (approximately 20%) compared to dealing direct with PPL PRS Ltd. Charges are based on the event’s attendance figures.
